



## 1. PERFORMANCE

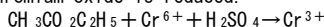
- 1) Measuring range : 10-1,000 ppm  
Number of pump strokes : 1(100mL)
- 2) Sampling time : 1.5 minutes/1 pump stroke
- 3) Detectable limit : 5 ppm
- 4) Shelf life : 2 years
- 5) Operating temperature : 10~40°C
- 6) Temperature compensation : Necessary (See "TEMPERATURE CORRECTION TABLE")
- 7) Reading : Direct reading from the scale calibrated by 1 pump stroke
- 8) Colour change : Yellow→Brown

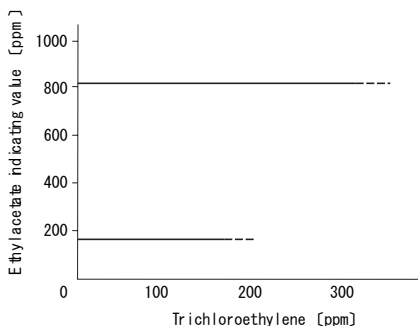


FIG. 1 Influence of Trichloroethylene
